4 deck design. 5 watertight bulkheads, breaking the ship into 6 watertight compartments.

Bridge Deck: Pilot house / life raft deck.

Upper Deck: 300 class staterooms: 8-2 person cabins; 2-1 person cabins; Captain's cabin.

Main Deck: 200 Class staterooms: 4 - 3 person cabins; 2 - 3 person crew quarters; Lounge and bar area, galley, dining room, galley storage,

Lower Deck: 100 Class staterooms: 13 - 2 person cabins; 4 - 2 person crew quarters, and 1 - 1 person crew quarters.

All passenger cabins have modular 'en-suite' heads, with continental showers. Vessel is fully air-conditioned.

Cabins: 27. Each cabin is outside and has a private bath with shower. Most have a window, but those on the lower deck only have porthole high on the wall, not usable for viewing. These cabins are less expensive. On Upper Deck there are two single cabins in the bow that have a window. Most cabins have two lower berths, two cabins have a double bed, and two also have an upper third berth. Two cabins aft on the Upper Deck have two picture windows. All have air-conditioning and heat control.

Dress: Casual or resort wear. High heels not recommended.

Facilities and Activities: The vessel has bow stairs. The forward lounge has picture windows lining the port and starboard sides and has a TV/VCR for videos and movies. The library has books about the regions visited and videos. You can visit the bridge at any time, including evening hours. There is no smoking inside the vessel.
